

Delhi Filming Logistics Checklist

Weather Overview & Tips

- * Summer (April to June): Very hot (35-45C). Ensure crew has hydration supplies, light clothing, and access to shade. Plan shoots early morning or post 4 PM.
- * Monsoon (July to September): Moderate to heavy rain. Carry plastic covers, waterproofing, and allocate buffer days.
- * Winter (December to February): Cold mornings and evenings (5-15C). Pack thermals, jackets, and fog lights for transport.
- * Autumn & Spring (Oct-Nov & Feb-Mar): Ideal weather with clear light. Plan bulk of exteriors in this window.

Lodhi Garden & Safdarjung Tomb	Nature / Royal look	6:30 AM - 9:00 AM	Golden hour; ASI permissions
Humayun's Tomb	Heritage + botanical	7:00 AM - 10:00 AM	Ticketed + ASI clearance
Hauz Khas Fort	Bohemian / youth	6:30 AM - 8:30 AM	Closes early
Qutub Minar Complex	Monumental	6:30 AM - 9:00 AM	Avoid weekends
Yamuna Ghat	Spiritual, river edge	Sunrise - 8:30 AM	Best in winters with birds
Okhla Bird Sanctuary	Wetlands / docu	6:00 AM - 8:30 AM	Forest department approval
Mehrauli Archeological Park	Grunge heritage	7:00 AM - 9:00 AM	Bring gear support
Jama Masjid / Chandni Chowk	Crowd, market, heritage	7-9 AM / 9 PM onwards	Early morning or night
Noida / Yamuna Expressway	Driving, drone	5:00 AM - 7:00 AM	Avoid traffic chaos
